
School Safety Spectrum

What Makes a School Safe?

- ✓ Ensuring no threatening, violent, and criminal behaviors.
- ✓ Allowing staff, students, and the community to feel connected to the school and able to participate in its major functions teaching and learning.

To have effective interventions, each school needs an INFRASTRUCTURE including:

- Teams
 - School Safety team
 - Treat Assessment team
- Data for decision making internal and external
- Staff for professional development
 - Emergency Response Plan
 - Bulling
 - Suicide
- Liaison district and community
