

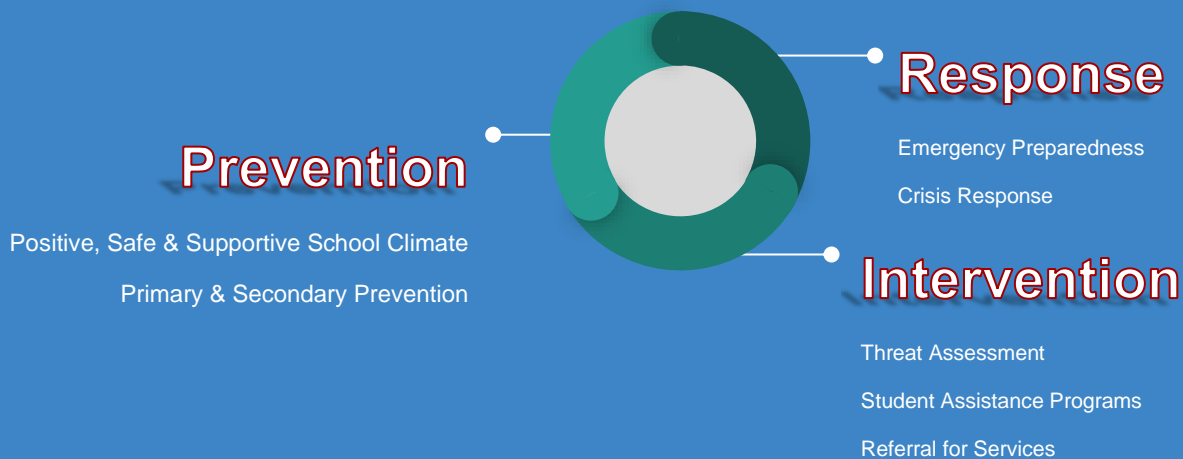
School Safety Spectrum

What Makes a School Safe?

- ✓ Ensuring no threatening, violent, and criminal behaviors.
- ✓ Allowing staff, students, and the community to feel connected to the school and able to participate in its major functions – teaching and learning.

To have effective interventions, each school needs an INFRASTRUCTURE including:

- ❖ Teams
 - School Safety team
 - Treat Assessment team
- ❖ Data for decision making – internal and external
- ❖ Staff for professional development
 - Emergency Response Plan
 - Bullying
 - Suicide
- ❖ Liaison – district and community
